Today, NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC announced their endorsement of Bill Montgomery for election to Maricopa County Attorney in the State of Arizona. NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC Chairman, Rear Admiral [Ret.] James J. Carey stated, "Bill Montgomery has NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC's full support for election to Arizona's Maricopa County Attorney. He served our country in the U.S. Army, putting himself on the line to defend our nation when called, led troops in Iraq, and is committed to keeping the promises made to our veterans when they agreed to risk their lives to face America's enemies. Bill is who we want in Maricopa County providing statesmanship, justice, and leadership. He understands what it takes to enforce the law, protect the citizens, and win against the challenges that face the people of Arizona. He also shares the values of the NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC and our desire to put military veteran statesmen into office."

Formally known as William Montgomery, Bill graduated West Point in 1989 and began his commission as a Second Lieutenant at Fort Hood, Texas. He was assigned as a Tank Platoon leader where he led his platoon as part of the 1st Cavalry Division on missions that would protect the operations of our troops from Iraqi forces who were determined to destroy our military during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm. Bill later received a Bronze Star Medal for Meritorious Service for his contribution in the defeat of Saddam Hussein, the liberation of Kuwait and the safe return of the 15 soldiers he led. Bill was later promoted to

the rank of Captain, and was one of only 9 Captains to be asked to command an Armored Cavalry Troop, one of the most prestigious assignments an armor officer could hold as Captain in the U.S. Army. Subsequent to active duty, Bill remained active in the Individual Ready Reserve another 9 years, achieving the rank of Major.

Admiral Carey stated, “The Maricopa County is home to many military veterans and an equally significant number of men and women, both active duty, guard & reserve, serving in the military today. They need Bill providing leadership and protecting their way of life. NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC intends to do all it can to help make that happen”.

Colonel (Ret.) Craig Carlson, National Defense PAC Executive Director, stated, “NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC has earned a reputation for endorsing winning candidates because we back men and women that have proven integrity forged in patriotic selfless military service.
